Brief Bio

Klaus Bosselmann is Professor of Law at the University of Auckland. He received his legal education in Germany and holds a PhD from the Freie Universität Berlin. He is the founding director of the New Zealand Centre for Environmental Law and teaches in the areas of international environmental law, global governance, European environmental law and comparative constitutional law. He has served as a consultant to the OECD, the EU and the governments of Germany and New Zealand and has been a visiting professor at leading universities in Europe, North America, Brazil and Australia. Prof Bosselmann is Chair of the IUCN World Commission on Environmental Law Ethics Specialist Group, Co-Chair of the Global Ecological Integrity Group and executive member of other international professional bodies.

He is author or editor of 27 books and over 120 book chapters and articles. In 2009 he was the Inaugural Winner of the Senior Scholarship Prize of the IUCN Academy of Environmental Law, the global body of environmental law scholars.
